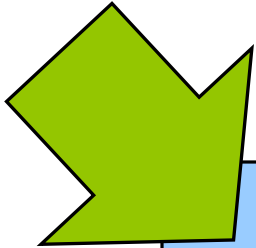
Involvement of partners in the preparation of:

- **Partnership agreements**
- **Operational Programmes**



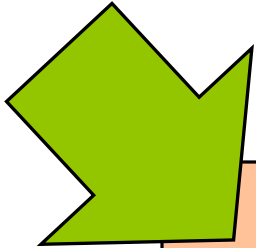
Consultation of partners:

- **timely disclosure of and easy access to relevant information**
- **sufficient time to analyse and comment**
- **available channels through which partners may ask questions, provide contributions and will be informed**
- **dissemination of the outcome of the consultation**



Involvement of partners in:

- **Calls for proposals**
- **Progress reports**
- **Monitoring and evaluation**



Strengthening the institutional capacity of partners:


- **Managing authorities can allocate part of their technical assistance to small local authorities, economic and social partners and NGOs**
- **support can take form of workshops, training sessions, coordination and networking structures**

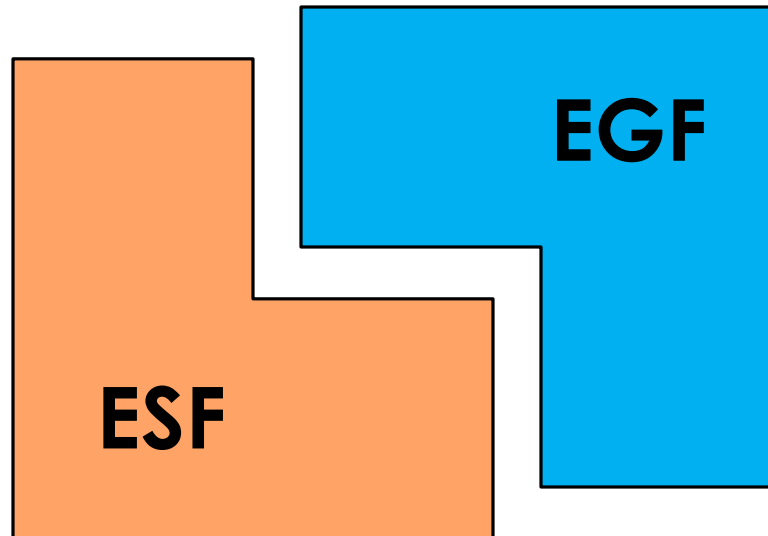
