



THE PARIS MANIFESTO

✓ A strong economy that serves the people

- ✓ Investment for full employment and quality jobs for all
- ✓ An end to austerity policies
- ✓ Better wages to boost internal demand, reduce inequalities and fight poverty
- ✓ Fundamental social rights must have precedence over economic freedoms.
- ✓ Policies for green jobs, a sustainable future, strong public services, fair taxation, an end to financial speculation and a revised European governance

✓ Stronger unions for democratic values and democracy at work.

- ✓ Social dialogue and collective bargaining must be respected and strengthened across Europe
- ✓ Greater workplace and industrial democracy, freedom of association and the right to strike
- ✓ We call for ETUC involvement in EU employment, economic and social policy-making.

✓ A core of ambitious social standards

- ✓ Implementation of a framework of labour and social rights aiming to achieve social progress
- ✓ An end to social dumping and deregulation
- ✓ We want fair and equal treatment for all workers, without discrimination


